THE LEGEND of Hart Ranch



During the time of the Black Hills Gold Rush, a young man claimed a chunk of land just outside of present-day Rapid City, South Dakota...

His name was John Harrison Hart, and he settled the ranch in the 1880s. It is only fitting that this land bares his name today. Hart was straight from the pages of Old West history, and he carved out his ranching empire while Wild Bill Hickok and Calamity Jane roamed the streets of Lead and Deadwood.

There is much about him, which is legend, but far more which is fact. This bull driver, Civil War fighter, scout, pioneer, and frontiersman blazed a reputation remembered even today by those who live around the ranch. The legend says he arrived in the Black Hills with only \$15 in his pocket and survived the first winter by chopping wood for 75 cents a cord. The facts show his hard work, entrepreneurial skills, and innovative mind parlayed what little he had into a successful freight line from Pierre to Rapid City and Cheyenne, Wyoming.

The legend says he never learned to drive a car, even though he lived to see World War II. The fact is that you still can find people who remember driving him around his ranch when – too old to ride a horse or wagon anymore – he just couldn't stand being away from the land he loved.

The final chapter of our story is the purchase of the 13,000-acre Hart Ranch in 1983 and the construction of the Camping Resort. In 1984 the membership was deeded for the 195-acre resort. There are several companies associated with the Hart Ranch name – Hart Ranch Golf Course and Hart Ranch Development Company. The Hart Ranch Camping Resort Club is an independent and separate corporation.

Check-in time for an RV or Tent Site is 2:00 PM. Check-in time for Cabins is 3:00 PM. Checkout time is 11:00 AM. Late fees will apply.

Resort activities information can be found on our cable channel 23, on our website at HRResort.org, on our app, Facebook page, or on our activities schedule available in the main lodge.

The **speed limit** is 10 MPH. Let us keep our children and pedestrians safe. Speeding fines will apply.

Quiet hours are from 10:00 PM to 7:30 AM.

Parking is limited to designated paved and gravel areas. Please do not park on the grass.

Pets are restricted to the south side of the resort, the dog run, Meadowlands, tent area and hiking trail. Leash laws are always in effect. Please clean up after your pets so we can all enjoy the grounds.

Tents must be off the grass from 9:00 AM to 7:00 PM (except in the designated tenting area). Limit two tents per site.

Sealed connections are required for all sewer hookups.

Alcohol is allowed at your site or unit, designated picnic shelters and at Hart Ranch hosted events.

Wood fires are prohibited at your site. However, propane fire pits, charcoal and propane grills are allowed.

Do not tie hammocks, clotheslines, pets, exercise bands, swings, bird feeders, or any other item to the trees, picnic tables, electrical posts, and other resort property.

Dispose of all garbage in the containers provided throughout the resort. Recycling bins are located at the entrance of the storage yard for glass, plastic, aluminum, and cardboard.

Please pick up after your pets, family and guests. This will help keep your maintenance fees low!

Be respectful of your fellow campers. Refrain from walking through campsites. Please use the roads.

If you are expecting visitors to your site or cabin, please notify the **Welcome Center** at **605-737-5370.**

If you have a **pet fence**, it can only be 100 sq. ft. and no more than 44" tall. In addition, please rotate it from one location to another to prevent the grass from being impacted.

Business Center: Head to the Lower Lodge where you will find computers with complimentary internet access and printers available for guest use.

Mail Forwarding: Become a legal resident of South Dakota. (No state income tax!) Ask the mailroom staff for details on how to forward your mail from your permanent home to Hart Ranch for your summer stay.

RV Storage: Short term storage is available for both members and non-members. Long-term camper storage is available for members only at reasonable rates. See the Front Desk for more information.

RV Storage Moves: For just \$20 each way, let our experienced movers take your camper out of storage and place it on your site! Same day storage moves are \$30 each way. When you are done, we will even move it back for you. Let us do the work!

- Repairing your vehicle or changing oil on your site is not allowed. Oil changes are available at the Maintenance Shop. Check with the shop staff to schedule an appointment.

LAUNDRY

Laundry facilities are available at all Comfort Stations, the Lower Lodge, and the Pool area. A laundry app is required to operate all washers and driers (no coin operated machines are on site). Credit cards may be used in lieu of the app in the Lower Lodge and main Laundry at the Pool area. The average cost of a load of laundry is \$2.50 to wash and \$2.25 to dry. 





BLACK HILLS Attractions ____



The Black Hills

When cavalry Colonel George Armstrong Custer first entered the Black Hills in 1874, he found a strikingly beautiful land filled with mountain meadows, granite spires and thick ponderosa forests. Nearly 140 years later, visitors to the Black Hills can still enjoy the same adventure, free roaming wildlife and breathtaking views that so impressed the explorers who came here so long ago.

With two million acres spanning a region of 120 miles long and 60 miles wide, it's practically an adventure just figuring out where to begin exploring the Black Hills. After all, this region is home to the highest concentration of public parks, monuments, and memorials in the nation.

Mount Rushmore National Museum

One of the nation's most recognizable icons, Mount Rushmore, depicts the faces of George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Theodore Roosevelt, and Abraham Lincoln, on the side of a granite mountain. You can walk all the way to the base of the massive memorial on the Presidential Trail, although a stop in the Borglum Museum first is a good way to learn more about the mountain's symbolism and history.

Wind Cave National Park

Guided tours of the sixth-longest cave in the world are the most popular feature of this park north of Hot Springs. In fact, adventurous explorers can sign up for the Wind Caving Tour, a four-hour excursion through the most remote areas of the cavern. Adventures await park visitors above the ground as well, where 28,295 acres of mixed-grass prairie and pine forest support a network of hiking trails and abundant wildlife. Bison, elk, pronghorn antelope, mule deer, coyotes and prairie dogs all inhabit Wind Cave National Park, making it the perfect stop for photographers and nature-lovers

Badlands National Park

Almost a quarter million acres of eroded buttes, jagged peaks and sandy plateaus make Badlands National Park one of the most striking landscapes in the world. Sunsets and sunrises are especially beautiful times of the day, casting hues of pink, yellow and orange against the rock walls. Wild bison, coyotes, bighorn sheep and prairie dogs roam freely within the park's borders.

BLACK HILLS Attractions ____



Devils Tower National Monument

Rising 1,267 feet straight out of the prairie, Devils Tower is perhaps best known for its role in Steven Spielberg's movie, "Close Encounters of the Third Kind." Designated as the nation's first national monument by President Theodore Roosevelt in 1903, Devils Tower is one of the most challenging rock-climbing destinations in the country. A number of less-strenuous hiking trails surround the tower itself, which rests along the red banks of the Belle Fourche River in northeastern Wyoming.



Crazy Horse Memorial

Crazy Horse Memorial[®] is located in the heart of the beautiful Black Hills. The elevation on the Mountain is 6,532 feet above sea level and ranks 27th highest mountain in South Dakota. It is made of pegmatite granite and was chosen by Sculptor Korczak Ziolkowski & Lakota Chief Henry Standing Bear for the Crazy Horse Memorial[®].



Custer State Park

This 71,000-acre nature preserve is the home of several camping facilities and rustic lodges, including the state Game Lodge, dubbed the "Summer White House" in 1927 when President Calvin Coolidge spent three months vacationing here with his family. Several lakes and streams provide fantastic fishing, while the 1,500 head of bison that call this place home – one of the largest publicly-owned herds in the world – put on a fantastic show during the annual Buffalo Roundup.



The Mickelson Trail

Converted from former railroad beds, the 109 miles of the Mickelson Trail bisects the entire length of the Black Hills, connecting Deadwood to Edgemont and passing through many central Black Hills communities along the way. In the summer it's used for hiking, mountain biking and horseback riding, and in the winter months it turns into a groomed snowmobile trail. Tunnels, waterfalls, ruined mining buildings and ghost towns are among the many sights of interest along the trail.

BLACK HILLS Attractions

Deadwood

There was a time when it wasn't safe to walk the boardwalks of the wildest town in the West, but that was a hundred years and a dozen gunfights ago. This is the town that welcomed Wild Bill Hickok, then wept when he was gunned down holding aces and eights, forever after known as the "Deadman's Hand." This is the place that witnessed the one-woman cyclone known as Calamity Jane, who claimed she could out-shoot, out-spit and out-swear any man, and usually did. Today, both are buried side-by-side in



Deadwood's "Boot Hill." Visitors now encounter brick streets, period lighting, old-time trolleys, Victorian facades and one of the largest historic preservation projects in the world, all fueled by an unlikely benefactor – limited stakes gaming, complete with poker, blackjack and the notorious one-armed bandits.



Spearfish Canyon

The breathtaking limestone palisades of this creek-carved gorge are more ancient than the Grand Canyon – albeit much closer together. The narrow walls of Spearfish Canyon, which rise up to 1,000 feet above the creek bed, are among the most spectacular scenery in the Black Hills. Cascading waterfalls quench the thirst of quaking aspen, gnarled oaks, sweet-smelling spruce and the ubiquitous ponderosa pine, which grow right off the edges of rocky precipices. The diverse array of plant life provides a comfortable home for deer, mountain goats, porcupines and bobcats. The canyon was accessible only by horseback until a railroad line to Deadwood was completed in 1893. When a flood in 1933 all but destroyed the tracks, a motorway was built right on top of the old rail bed.

Today, this road is US 14A, one of America's few scenic byways. The highway continues through the canyon for nearly 20 miles, affording visitors views of both its pristine natural wonders and its historical treasures. Near the middle of the canyon is the old sawmill town of Savoy, which provides a jumping off point for several scenic hikes and forays into ancient mining and logging camps. Further up the canyon is Cheyenne Crossing, the point where the gold-rush era Deadwood-Cheyenne stage line crossed Spearfish Creek.

BLACK HILLS Attractions



Centennial Trail

Marking the 100th anniversary of statehood, 1889 - 1989, the 111-mile Centennial Trail represents the diversity of South Dakota. The Trail crosses prairie grasslands near Bear Butte State Park and climbs into the Black Hills, high country, skirting lakes, and streams until it reaches Wind Cave National Park near Hot Springs. The Forest Service, Bureau of Land Management, National Park Service and South Dakota Department of Game, Fish and Parks have combined their efforts to develop this Trail for you to enjoy.

Approximately 22 miles of the trail are located within Custer State Park. This trail offers opportunities to view the natural and cultural resources of the Black Hills.

Three trailheads provide access points to Custer State Park's portion of the trail. The trail is marked with a combination of brown fiberglass posts and gray diamonds fastened to trees. This trail is also used by horse riders and mountain bikers.

The Centennial Trail was officially opened in June 1989, in commemoration of the South Dakota centennial.



BLACK HILLS NATIONAL FOREST Motorized Trail System Over 3,600 miles of roads for ATV, UTV, and other off-road riders.

There are 1.2 million beautiful acres of the Black Hills National Forest in western South Dakota. And offroad enthusiasts can access and enjoy many thousands of those acres by using the Black Hills National Forest Motorized Trail System - consisting of over 3,600 miles of roads and over 600 miles of trails for ATV, UTV, and other off-road riders. Included are 90 miles of singletrack trails for motorcycles; 347 miles of trails for vehicles 62 inches and less in width in South Dakota; and 72 miles of trails for vehicles 50 inches and less in width in Wyoming. There are also 148 miles of trails open to all. The system incorporates many looped trails and includes parking access from 20 trailheads.

It is important to obtain the most current Black Hills Forest Service map when you come to the Black Hills to ride. The map is updated annually to correct mapping errors, add newly constructed motorized trails, or remove motorized trails that are in timber sale areas. Routes are not always signed on the ground but will be identified on the map. It is your responsibility to stay on the designated trails.

With the Motorized Trail System, the Black Hills National Forest is closed to cross-country travel unless designated open, meaning it is illegal for most users to travel off the designated trails.

The Black Hills National Forest encourages all motorized users to follow the Tread Lightly!

Pledge Travel and recreate with minimum impact. Respect the environment and the rights of others; Educate yourself – plan and prepare before you go. Allow for future use of the outdoors – leave it better than you found it. Discover the rewards of responsible recreation. ATVs in South Dakota are governed by state motorcycle law. There is no minimum age or license for off-road drivers; however, manufacturer's operator guidelines should be followed. On-the-road drivers need a valid driver's license and a licensed ATV. ATV use is prohibited on the interstate highway system.

For current and downloadable Motor Vehicle Use Maps (MVUM) and related documents and files, including a question and answer sheet, searchable legend and map text, and other user aids or by visiting on the motor vehicle use map (MVUM) section on the Black Hills National Forest website.

Trail system fees are \$20 a week per vehicle or \$25 for an annual pass. Motorized trail permits to use the system are available at Forest Service offices, outlets and online.

Forest Service offices are open from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. weekdays. For folks arriving during the weekend, permits are available at Black Hills Visitor Information Center, located at I-90, Exit 61. Hours at the visitor center are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily year-round. During the summer season, hours are from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

A permit is required on each vehicle on the trail system, and all motorized trail permits are non-refundable and non-transferable. A free map is provided with each permit purchased. Users should check with their local Forest Service office if they have further questions about the map and/or permits.

Another popular riding area for dirt biking and ATV riding is located on the north edge of the Buffalo Gap National Grasslands, south of Farmingdale. The dirt bluffs and grassy knobs at the Railroad Buttes ORV Area are filled with challenging trails and jumps. Go only when it's dry; in wet weather, this area is a quagmire of slippery, supersticky clay that locals call "gumbo."

For further information please examine the rules for offhighway vehicles in South Dakota state parks. For OTV riding in Buffalo Gap National Grasslands & other National Grasslands. You can also check out information posted by the local off-road organization.





How do I know if I have a compatible device?

» If the device has a web browser it should be compatible. If you have any questions regarding compatibility, please consult your devices manufacturer's manual for further information.

» Not all smart TVs are compatible, so be sure your smart TV is capable of connecting to Wi-Fi networks. Please walk through your on- screen prompts prior to purchase to verify compatibility.

Is the Wi-Fi secure?

» Your connection to the Hart Ranch Wi-Fi Networks is intrinsically safe. Connected Network device are unable to share information or otherwise be compromised by other connected network devices.

How much bandwidth should I have?

» This is certainly subject to your device's antenna and ability to receive Wi-Fi in or around your location. We have set the minimum level of bandwidth at 10mg down and 5mg up. This, however, is operating in perfect conditions without interference. Gaming and/or excessive streaming may result in slow download and upload speeds.

What if my Wi-Fi connection drops?

» Wi-Fi by nature may drop from time to time due to several factors ranging from weather, other devices, or your device losing connection. If you have recently rebooted your device or returned to the campground and your device does not re-establish on it its own, you may need to go to your Wi-Fi settings and connect to the Hart Ranch network again. If this does not work, please go to Wi-Fi, and click forget this network and reestablish again.

The internet doesn't work inside my RV and only works outside my RV.

» If this is occurring, then the network is working properly. In some cases, depending on the construction of your RV, signals can be blocked inside the RV. This happens more frequently on metal or aluminum sided RV's. This type of siding can either block or minimize the Wi-Fi signal.

» This issue in most cases can be remedied by purchasing and installing an antenna, which are available for purchase at a local retailer.

I can only get a few TV channels, or my channels are grainy/fuzzy.

» If you cannot get all of your TV channels, perform a channel scan so your television can acquire all of the channels offered at Hart Ranch.

» If your channels are fuzzy, make sure your antenna amplifier is shut off. This generally is a small button next to the main cable jack in your RV.
